#### iReady Diagnostic Testing

Students in grades 1 - 5 will take a second *i-Ready* assessment in January. Below, you will find information about the program and how teachers use it in the classroom.

#### What is i-Ready?

i-Ready is an online program that will help us determine your child's strengths and areas for growth, personalize their learning, and monitor their progress throughout the school year. i-Ready allows us to meet your child where they are and provides us with data to inform instruction.

The *i-Ready Diagnostic* is an adaptive assessment that adjusts its questions to suit your child's needs. Each item a student receives is based on their answer to the previous question. For example, a series of correct answers will result in slightly harder questions, while a series of incorrect answers will yield slightly easier ones. The purpose of this is not to give your child a score or grade but to determine how to best support their learning.

When will your child take the test?

- Math Testing: January 18<sup>th</sup> and/or 19<sup>th</sup>
- Reading Testing: January 24th and/or 25th

#### What can I do to help?

To help prepare your child for the *i-Ready Diagnostic*, encourage them to:

- Get a good night's sleep and eat a full breakfast the day of the assessment.
- Try their best on each question and try not to rush.
- Try not to worry about questions to which they do not know the answers—remind them that it is expected that they will

- only get about half of the questions correct.
- Be respectful of other students who take longer to finish.
- Use paper and pencil to show work for math questions.

#### What happens next?

- The i-Ready Diagnostic will provide results that help identify your child's strengths and determine next steps for instruction. Results will be shared with parents when all students have completed testing.
