Quarantined students who are well and able to participate in academic activities through Matula's Continuity of Learning Plan will be marked present.

In order to be marked present, the student must complete the daily attendance form

located in the teacher's Absent Folder by 9:45 AM each day he is absent and submit all completed assignments when he returns to the building.
